(3) Eligibility for application

All IBA students are eligible to apply.

(4) Requirement of English proficiency

It is preferable, but not necessary, to have at least an intermediate level of English which is the equivalent of IELTS 5.0, TOEFL(iBT)45 or TOEIC600.

(5) Expenses

CAD2,900+145 (tax) = CAD3,045 for Module 1

CAD3,250+162.5 (tax) = CAD3,412.5 for Module 2 or 3

CAD8,600+430 (tax) = CAD9,030 for Full program (3 Modules)

*Registration in Modules 1 and 3 combined will require accommodation for the full program

◆What's included:

(6) Accommodation

Cluster unit. Private bedroom with shared kitchen, living room, dining room and washroom.

(7) Activities

A number of activities are included in the program fees.

There are also a few optional activities for an additional fee.



III. Application Procedure

(1) Procedures required by the IBA office

First of all, you should receive the associate or assistant dean's approval and his/her signature on the prescribed application form before applying. Then, please submit the following application documents by the deadline.

Application deadline : April 24, 2026 16 : 50

Where to submit : IBA Office (Nishinomiya Uegahara Campus)

Required documents : Following 1~7 (For 7, if you wish.)

1. Application form (prescribed form)

*** You should contact the associate or assistant dean and ask for the approval in advance. Associate or assistant dean's approval or signature is required.**

2. Pledge form (prescribed form) *Japanese only

3. Health check application (prescribed form) *Japanese only

4. A copy of the passport

5. Hardcopy of eTA *Refer to ※ 1 and ※ 2 .

6. Flight information

* If you haven't booked yet, please submit as soon as you book.

7. Study Abroad Scholarship application form and your bank account information
(prescribed form) * only if you wish

(2) Procedures required by UVic

① Please submit the "Summer Programs Registration Form" to the UVic office by email by the deadline. The form is posted on Kwic.

**※Please make sure to identify yourself as a Kwansei Gakuin University student;
Otherwise, the partner pricing will not apply.**

② After UVic receives your application, they will provide payment instructions to finalize your enrollment. Please follow these instructions carefully and complete the payment.

※ 1 eTA

Please see the Canadian government's official web-page (<https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/visit-canada/eta/facts-ja.html>)

You should get eTA by yourself.

Your passport and credit card or debit card are needed at the time of online application.

※ 2 When you need a visa to enter Canada (for international students)

Depending on your nationality, you should have “Temporary Resident Visa.” If the country of your origin is one of the listed “Temporary Resident Visa Required Countries,” you should follow the required procedure and complete it by the end of May. You should apply for the VISA by yourself.

*** In case you require an acceptance letter from UVic, you should contact UVic office immediately.**

(3) Travel insurance

You should purchase “Overseas Travel Insurance” and “Safety Insurance (Organizer Insurance)”. You can apply for those insurances offered by Ji Accident & Fire insurance Co., Ltd. when you fill in the program’s application form.

You should pay the insurance premiums apart from the program fees. Please fill in your desired coverage period in the program’s application form. In principle, you can apply for the coverage including 1 day or 2 days before and after the program period in which you participate. After we receive your application for the program, we will issue an invoice around mid-May.

(4) Study Abroad Total Support Program

Cost : JPY 2,750 (within 1 month)

You can consult with professionals 24 hours a day regarding any trouble, accident, or distress during your trip. We have you to join this service so that you can concentrate on the program in the country where you study.

You should pay for this service apart from the program fees. Upon your application for the program, you will receive an invoice for this service (in addition to the insurance premium) after the middle of May. The details will follow.

IV. Scholarships

You can apply for the scholarship of “Short-term Study Abroad Scholarship”. If you are selected, the scholarship of JPY 80,000 will be granted.

You should submit a “Study Abroad Scholarship’s application form” and a “Bank account information form” (prescribed forms ; posted on kwic) along with the program application form. The scholarship will be paid after you complete the program.

(Deadline : April 24, 2026)

V. Taking IBA regular courses in the 2nd Quarter

As a general rule, students are not allowed to take IBA courses that overlap with their study abroad period of this UVic program. However, students may take online or Hy-flex courses offered by IBA only when they do not significantly interfere with their studies of this UVic program. If you wish to take IBA courses during this UVic program, please prepare for the local environment in Canada and carefully consider the time difference.

Notes:

- No special consideration will be given to your attendance at IBA courses when you take IBA courses during this UVic program.
- Students are required to register for IBA courses by themselves during the registration period of the second quarter.
- If you take AS or CMSC courses (besides IMC courses), please make sure to complete its application as well.

VI. Approval of credits

Up to 6 credits as an advanced course

* Approved as "Study Abroad at Partnership Universities" for IMC students.

(As per Cross-Cultural Management, this could be approved as "Cross Cultural Management" at IBA if certain conditions are met after reviewed syllabi.)



To obtain credits, submit transcripts from UVic (copy) as well as a Credits Approval Application (prescribed form ; posted on kwic) to the IBA office by July 31.

※In addition to that, please submit your study abroad experience note (see the following section) by the deadline.

※In case you already obtained "Cross Cultural Management" of IBA, whether you can get credit of Cross-Cultural Management of UVic will be decided after we check syllabi. If it will be approved, credit will be counted as "Study Abroad at Partnership Universities".

VII. Experiences of Study Abroad
