- Entry (Application) Deadline: October 30th, 2023 (Earlier Entry is welcome.)
- Articles are accepted both in Japanese and English. Number of pages should be around 20 pages.
- Document page setting should comply with the following.

Style: Microsoft Word, text data, or TeX (mathematical formula) (B5 paper, 80 one-byte characters per line, 33 lines per page)

Font size

Title: 16 points
Sub title: 11 points

Author's name: 10 points (Title and author's name: 7-line)

Abstract: 8 points, 74 one-byte characters per line

Numbers (I, II...): 10 points (two-line)

Body text: 9 points

Note, Reference: 8 points, 86 one-byte characters per line, 39 lines per page For details, please refer to "Writing Guidelines for Business & Accounting Review".

- Co-writing with outside-of-university persons is also accepted.
- Submission deadline is <u>December 15th, 2023</u>. (Strict adherence to the deadline is requested). Publication is scheduled on June 30th, 2024.
